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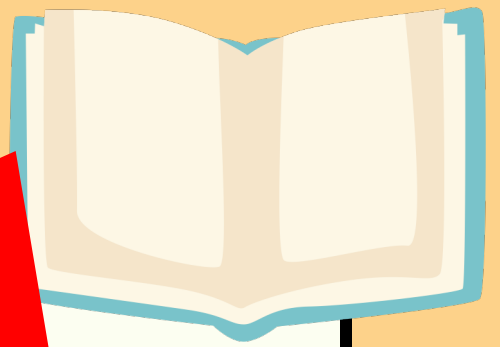

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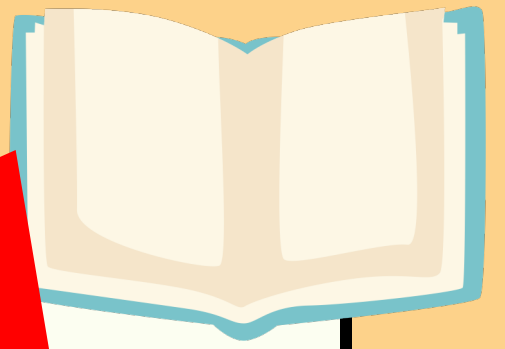

- use simple words when we speak and write





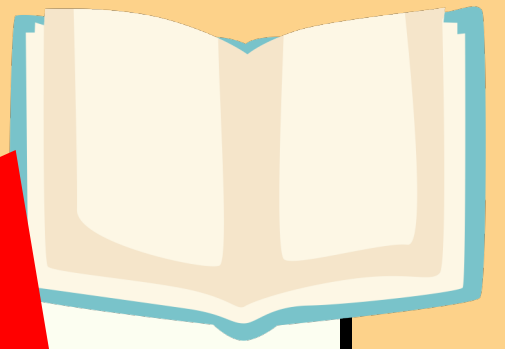
The Digraph sh

Say each word slowly. What sound does sh make?





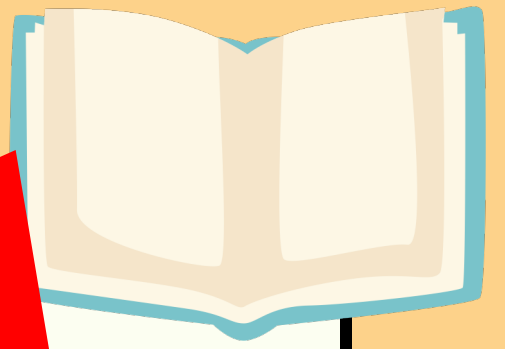
The Digraph ch

Say each word slowly. What sound does ch make?





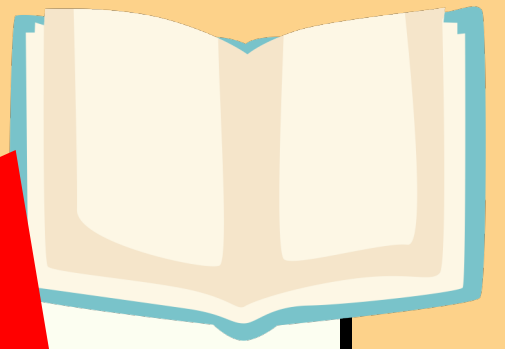
The Digraph th

Say each word slowly. What sound does th make?





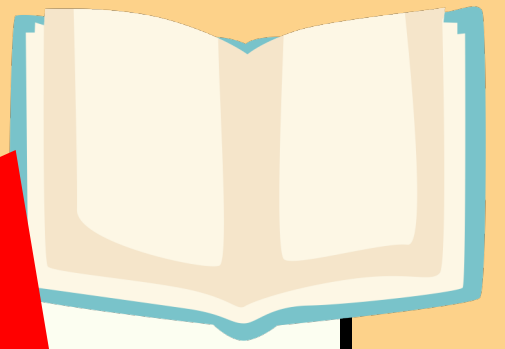
The Digraph wh

Say each word slowly. What sound does wh make?





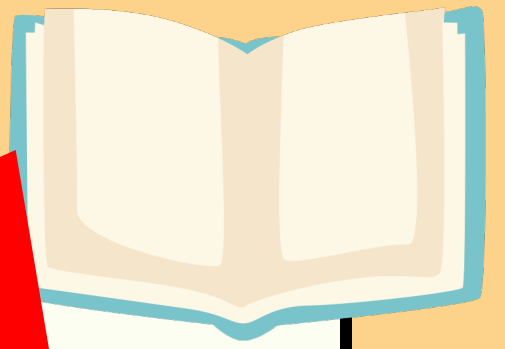
The Digraph ph

Beginning. ip, ck, th b

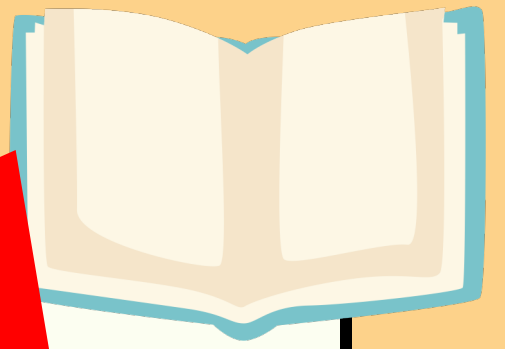
fish, l bath

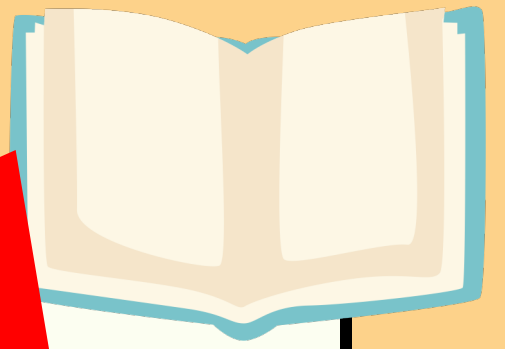
Hear the Sound

sh + ip = ship

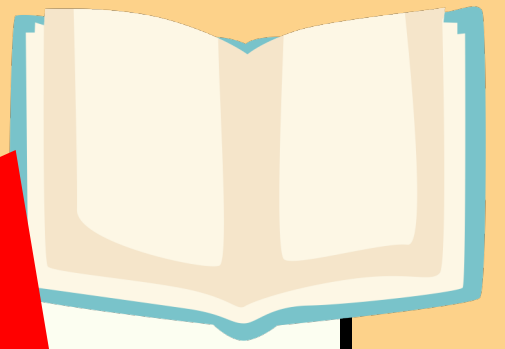
pea ch = peach

1. Spot the digraph.

3. Blend the whole word.

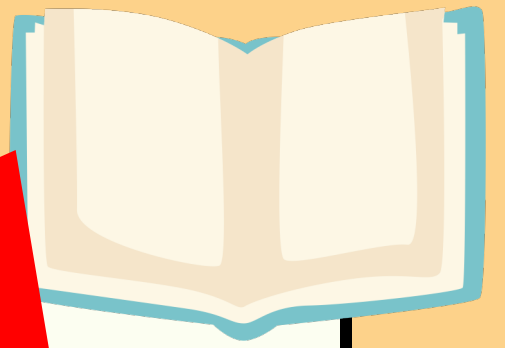
ch - c → ch

Use a Digraph Word

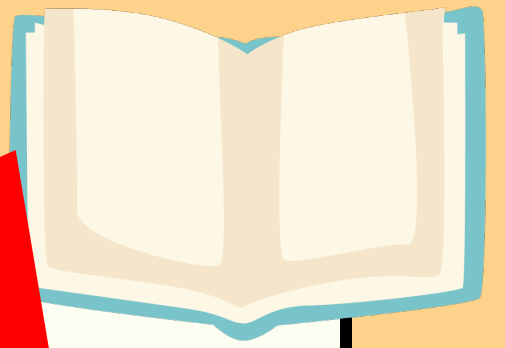


I sit on the chair.
