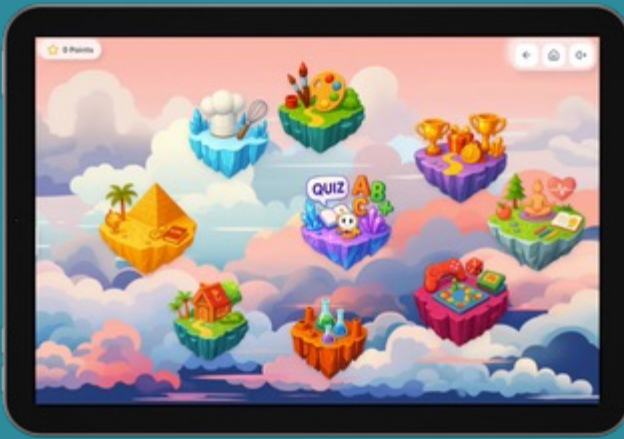

Learning Goal

We can recognise, name and show halves, quarters and eighths using equal parts.



Fractions Need Equal Parts

A fraction shows equal parts of a whole or equal groups in a collection. Unequal parts are not fair fraction parts.



One Half

One half means 1 of 2 equal parts. We write it as $\frac{1}{2}$.



One Quarter

One quarter means 1 of 4 equal parts. Four quarters make one whole.



One Eighth

One eighth means 1 of 8 equal parts. Eight eighths make one whole.



Words And Symbols

Read the symbol, say the word name, then check the model: $\frac{1}{2}$

one half, $\frac{1}{4}$ one quarter, $\frac{1}{8}$ one eighth.



Wholes And Collections

Fractions can show part of one whole shape or part of a collection,
such as $\frac{1}{4}$ of 12 shells.



Compare Models

Different models can show the same amount. Two quarters and four eighths can both show one half.



Measuring With Fractions

We can split lengths, strips and spaces into equal parts to describe halves, quarters and eighths.
