Meet the Long E Sound

Long E sounds like the name of the letter E.

See, green, beach, please, happy, key.

Stretch the vowel sound: /ee/.

The sound can be written in more than one way.



The ee Pattern

Two e letters often work together.

Words: tree, green, deep, sheep, feet.

Say each word slowly.

What stays the same?



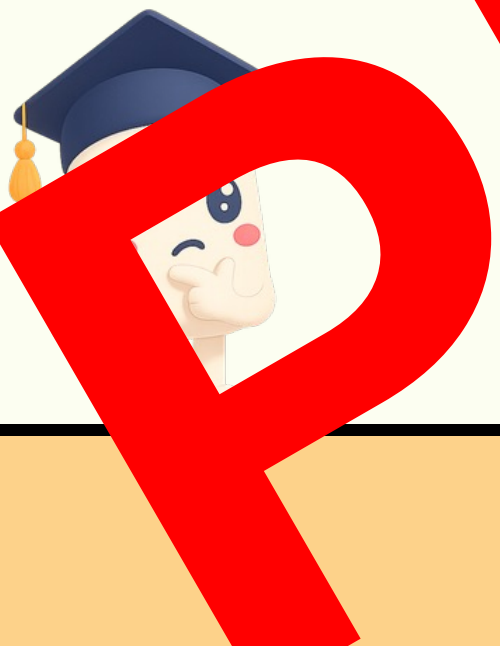
The ea Pattern

The letters e and a can spell long E.

Words: beach, sea, cream, peach, read.

Look at the letters before and after ea.

Read each word aloud.



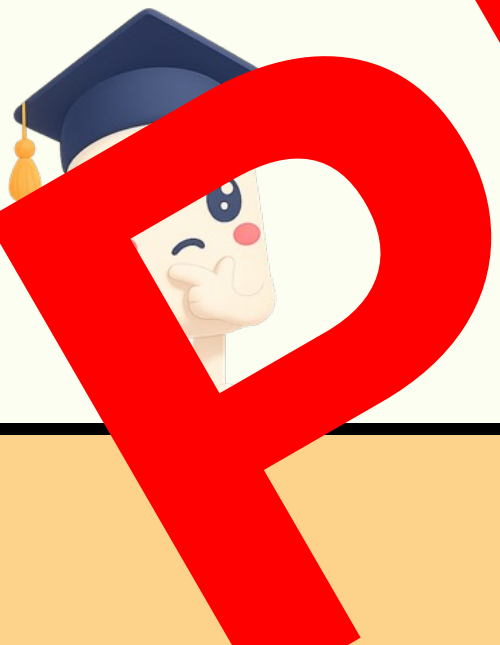
The ie Pattern

In some words, ie tells us long E.

Words: piece, thief, relief.

Remember: Not all ie words sound the same.

Check the word, then check its sound.



The Final y Pattern

At the end of many words is a sound like long E.

Words: happy, sunny, puppy, tiny.

The long E sound is at the end.

Clap the syllables and listen.



The ey Pattern

At the end of some words, the sound is like long E.

Words: key, monkey, money, turkey.

Use the e and y work together.

Pay attention to the ending clearly.



Say, Stretch, Map, Spell

1. Say the whole word.
2. Stretch the long E sound.
3. Map the sound to the spelling.
4. Spell the word.
5. Read it back and check.

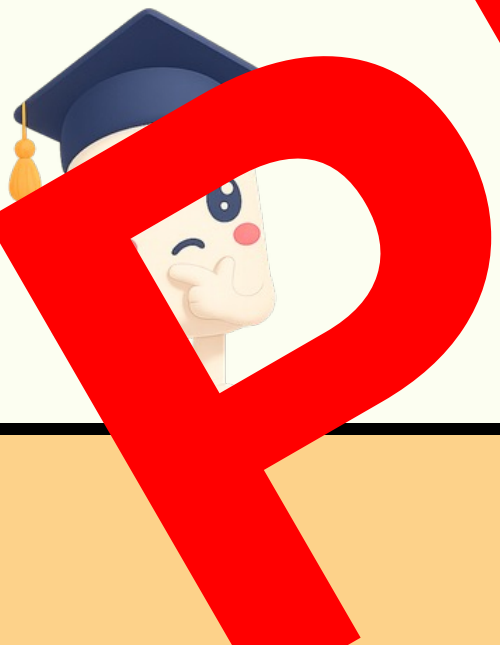

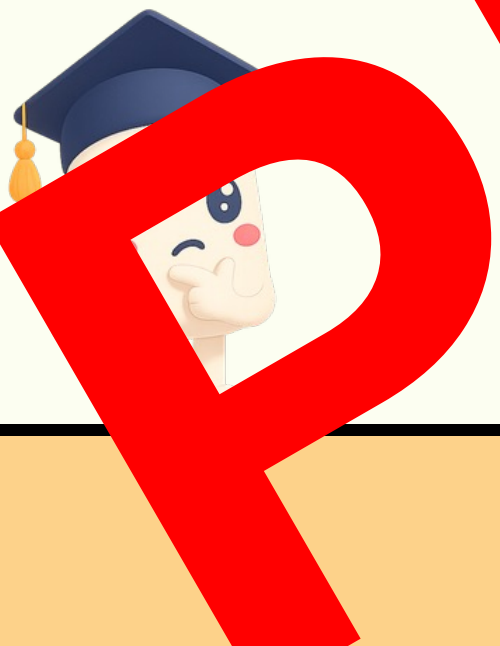

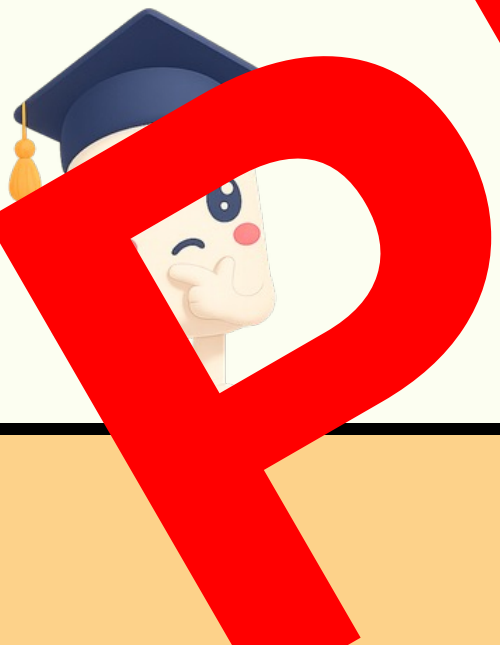
