What Are Screen Texts?

Screen texts are texts we read on a screen.
They can be websites, apps, games, videos or online stories.





Why Navigate?

Navigation helps us get to the right place.

Good readers use screen clues to find information quickly and safely.





Homepage And Home Button

A homepage is the start of a website.

The home button takes you back to the start.





Search Bars

A search bar is where you type a word or topic.
It helps you find information without checking every page.





Useful Keywords

A keyword is an important search word.

Use clear keywords such as frog facts or Hobart weather.





Links

A link opens another page.

Links can be words, pictures or buttons.





Buttons

Buttons tell the screen what to do.
They might say Next, Play, Search or Learn More.





Menus

A menu shows different sections.
Choose the section that matches the information you need.

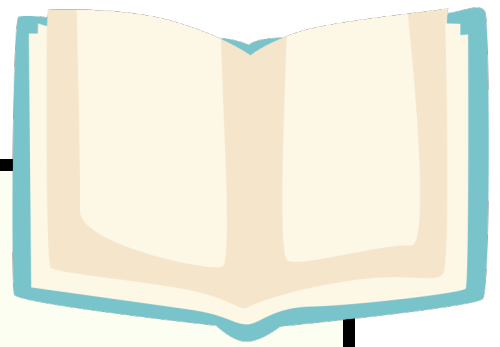




Tabs

Tabs help you switch between open pages or sections.
Check the tab name before you click.





Scrolling

Scrolling moves the page up or down.
Use it when information continues below the screen.





Headings And Captions

Headings tell you what a page or section is about.

Captions explain pictures and diagrams.





Back And Forward

The back button returns to the last page.

The forward button moves ahead again after you go back.





Safe Screen Choices

Pop-ups can be ads or messages.

Close unexpected pop-ups and ask an adult before clicking.
