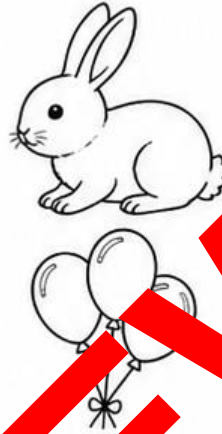
NOUN GROUPS

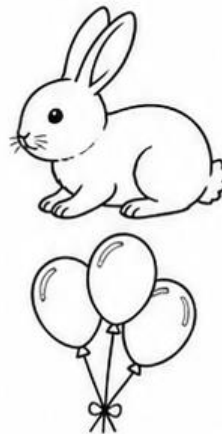
