What Will We Learn?

Teen Numbers

Teen numbers are 11 to 19.

Each has 1 ten and some more ones.

Example: $13 = 10 + 3$.



Build Teen Numbers

PREVIEW

$$11 = 10 + 1$$

$$14 = 10 + 4$$

$$18 = 10 + 8$$

$$20 = 10 + 10$$



Numbers 11, 12 and 13

11: eleven: 1 ten and 1 one

12: twelve: 1 ten and 2 ones

13: thirteen: 1 ten and 3 ones



Numbers 14, 15 and 16

14: fourteen: 1 ten and 4 ones

15: fifteen: 1 ten and 5 ones

16: sixteen: 1 ten and 6 ones



Numbers 17, 18 and 19

17: seventeen: 1 ten and 7 ones

18: eighteen: 1 ten and 8 ones

19: nineteen: 1 ten and 9 ones



Twenty
