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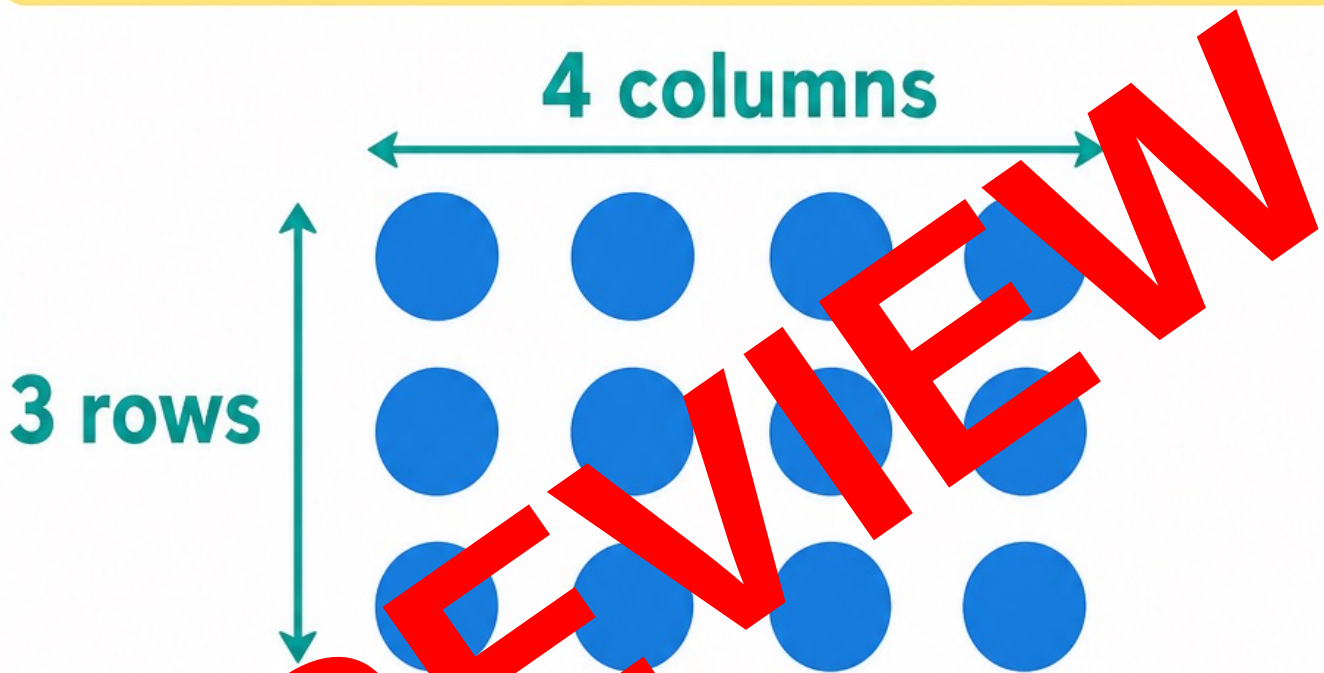
Simple Division Using Arrays - Year 2

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DIVISION WITH ARRAYS

Arrays have equal rows and equal columns.



$$12 \div 3 = 4$$

12 shared into 3 rows gives 4 in each row.



$$12 \div 4 = 3$$

12 shared into 4 columns gives 3 in each column.



$$\text{CHECK: } 3 \times 4 = 12$$

Simple Division Using Arrays



Our Learning Goal

Use equal groups and arrays to solve division problems.



What Is Division?

Division means sharing a total into equal groups.



Equal Groups

Every equal group has the same number of objects.

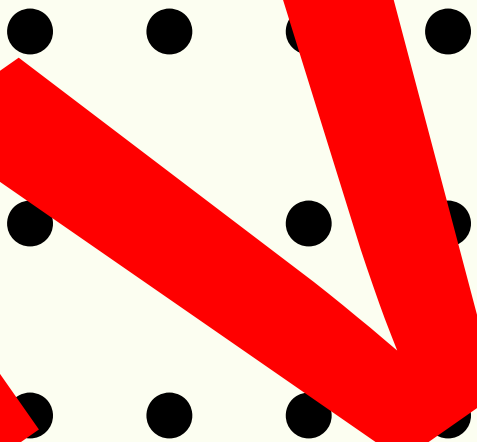


Rows and Columns

Rows go across. Columns go down.



Count This Array



Divide by the Rows

3 equal rows: $12 \div 3 = 4$ in each row.



Divide by the Columns

4 equal columns: $12 \div 4 = 3$ in each column.



Turn the Array

3×4 and 4×3 both make 12



A Related Fact Family

$$3 \times 4 = 12 \quad 4 \times 3 = 12 \quad 12 \div 3 = 4 \quad 12 \div 4 = 3$$



Example: $8 \div 2$

Make 2 equal rows of The quotient is 4.



Example: $15 \div 3$

Make 3 equal rows of The quotient is 5.



Example: $20 \div 4$

Make 4 equal rows of . The quotient is 5.



Partition 18

Split 18 into 3 equal rows of 6 each.



Two Ways to See 18

18 can be 3 rows of 6 or 6 rows of 3.

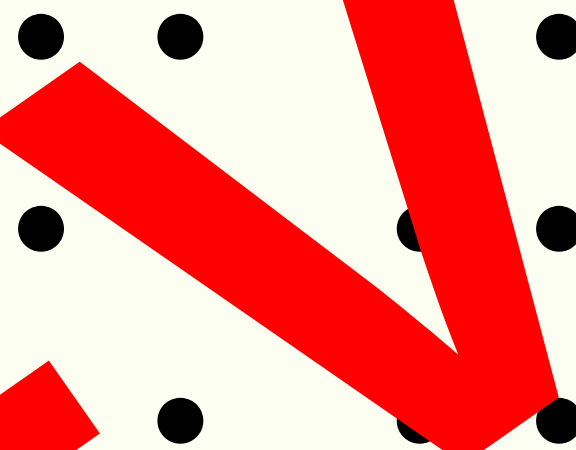

Two equal rows have 6 dots each. One-half of 12 is 6, so $12 \div 2 = 6$.

In a 4-by-4 array, one-quarter of 16 is 4: $16 \div 4 = 4$.

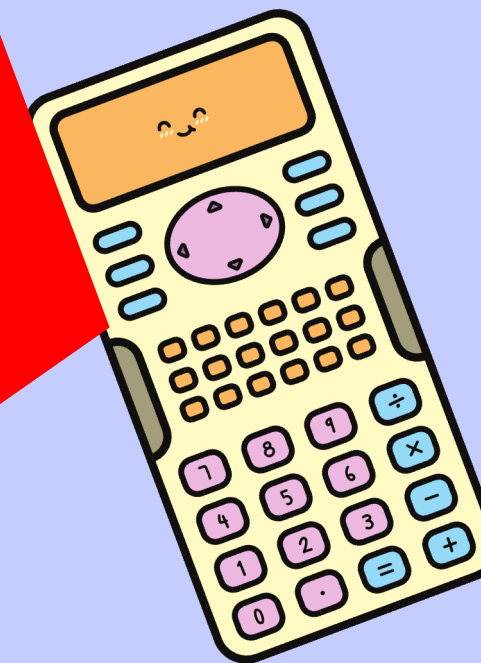
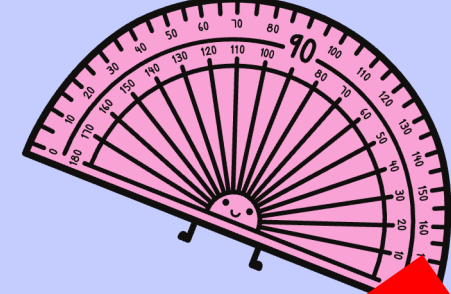
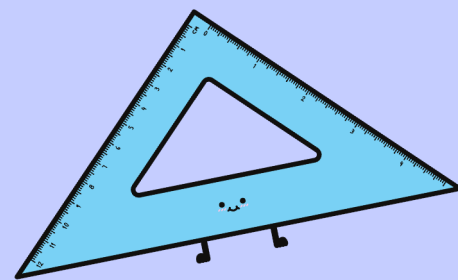
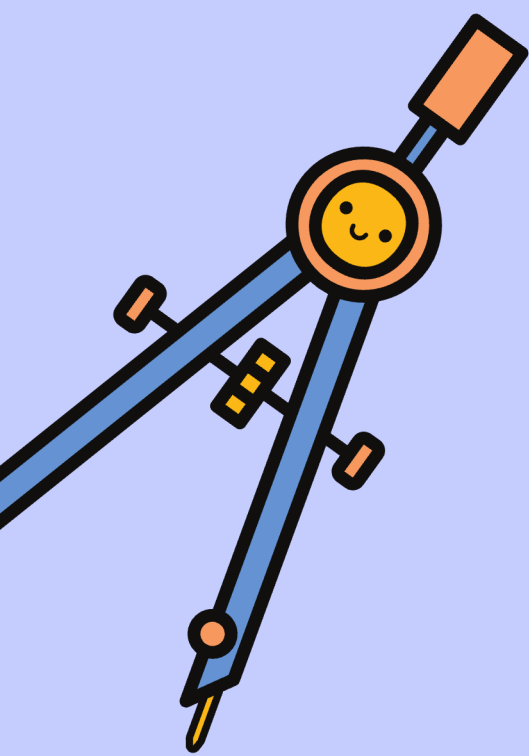
